<b>Project title:</b>	<b>Connecting the Arts: UQ Art Museum Winter Research Scholarship</b>
<b>Project duration:</b>	Four weeks, three days per week, 10am to 5.00pm per day. Scheduled from mid-June to mid-July, exact dates to be negotiated with the successful applicant. The student will be required to attend the Program welcome.
<b>Description:</b>	<p>Learning and engagement are central to our work at the UQ Art Museum. Our Education unit is a primary point of connection between the Art Museum, the University's students and staff, broader audiences and stakeholders.</p> <p>The Education unit serves several purposes. In conjunction with other Art Museum units, these span collaborative engagements with staff and students to research, develop and deliver creative, educative programming, tailored student learning initiatives, training and mentorships, and the involvement of the wider community with our venue and its activities.</p> <p>The student will work with staff across the closely integrated areas of events, marketing/communications and education/public programming to help develop and deliver creative, educative programming.</p>
<b>Expected outcomes and deliverables:</b>	<p>It is expected that the student will work closely with the Education Unit to realise events during their time at the Art Museum, which may consist of artists' floor talks, symposia, music and performance events, up-late evenings and discussion panels.</p> <p>They will also gain skills in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• working as part of a cross-disciplinary team of curators, educators, communicators, registrars and front-of-house staff</li> <li>• researching and delivering education related programs</li> <li>• developing publicity materials, including articles for e-newsletters and social media posts</li> </ul>
